The Danubius Award was created in 2011 by the <u>Institute for the Danube Region</u> and Central Europe (<u>IDM</u>) and the Austrian Federal Ministry for Science, Research and Economy (BMWFW) with the intention to honor persons with extraordinary achievements in their scientific activity and output in relation to the Danube Region. 2016 this award has been, for the third time, complemented with a specific price for young scientists - the "Danubius Young Scientist Award".


